Maria Guinand, choral conductor, conducts the Cantoría Alberto Grau and the Schola Cantorum de Venezuela with which she has recorded and toured extensively. Conductor of the National Symphonic Choir of Venezuela, she collaborates closely with the Simón Bolívar Symphony Youth Orchestra preparing choirs for conductors such as Rattle, Abbado, Rilling, Mata, Alcantara, Grau, Abreu, Penderecki, among others.

During the European Music Festival in 2000, she premiered Golijov's St. Mark's Passion. Its recording by Haenssler Verlag was nominated for the Grammy prize in 2002, and in 2007, she recorded it with Deutsche Gramophon for release in March 2010. In 2006, she prepared the Schola Cantorum de Venezuela for the premiere of John Adams' opera A Flowering Tree during the Festival 'New Crowned Hope' in Vienna, under John Adams and Peter Sellars. She was the conductor of the Festival's Choir for the European Music Festival from 2001-2004.

Frequently invited as guest conductor in North and South America, Europe and Asia, Ms. Guinand specializes in Latin American Choral Music of the 20th and 21st centuries. In 2009 she conducted Golijov's St. Mark's Passion in the Canary Islands, participated with the Cantoría Alberto Grau at the ACDA national convention in Oklahoma, and conducted the Nacional Choir of Spain and the Schola Cantorum de Venezuela at the Mostly Mozart Festival in New York. In October 2009, she was guest conductor at the celebration of the World Youth Choir's 20th Anniversary in Örebro, Sweden.
